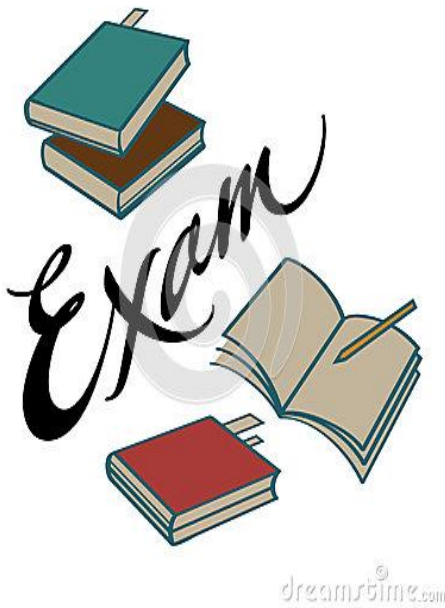

Monday Presentations

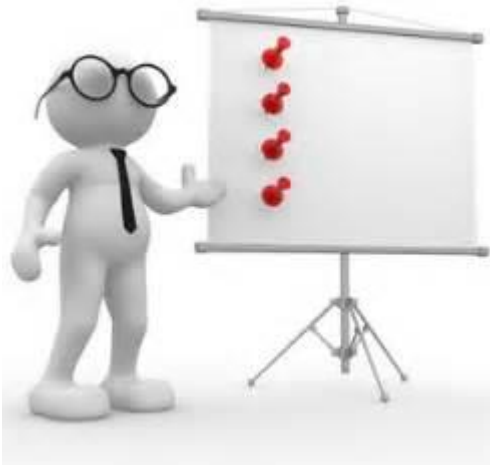

The bottles of enzymes were being opened and closed to release the air.

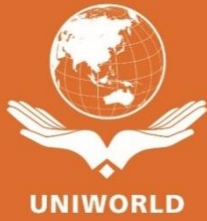
